Advanced Intensive Training In Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT) Seattle, WA: September 22-26, 2008

PREREQUISITE:

Participants are required to have completed the 10-Day Intensive Training with Behavioral Tech, LLC

Behavioral Tech, LLC is pleased to offer an Advanced Intensive Training led by Marsha Linehan, Ph.D. This is only the second time this training has been offered, the first being in 2003. This course is specifically designed for advanced practitioners of DBT. Different than other formats, this workshop is designed only for those mental health professionals who are conducting Individual DBT psychotherapy and have completed the 10-day Intensive Training course through Behavioral Tech, LLC. We invite you to take this training as an individual or with your team.

Dr. Linehan and other course faculty will teach the latest of the late on topics that are the toughest and most relevant to individual psychotherapists (e.g., conducting a competent behavioral analysis including accurate problem definition, behavioral assessment and chain analysis). In addition, one day will be spent on using the consultation team and two evenings will be dedicated to mindfulness practice. Teaching topics will be interwoven with role-plays and experiential practices that will strengthen participants' capacity to do specific DBT strategies.

There will be daily review of videotaped psychotherapy sessions in both small and large group formats. Each day in a small group format, Dr. Linehan will review one participant's psychotherapy tape and each participant will have the opportunity to join at least one small group discussion with Dr. Linehan. In a daily large group format, experts at coding adherence to DBT will review tapes from Dr. Linehan's research clinic and strengthen participants' capacities to assess which strategies are in use.

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INFORMATION ABOUT THE INSTRUCTORS

Marsha Linehan, Ph.D., ABPP, is a Professor of Psychology and an Adjunct Professor of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at the University of Washington. She is the treatment developer of Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT), one of the empirically supported therapies that integrate mindfulness with standard cognitive-behavioral therapy. She has received numerous awards recognizing her clinical and research contributions, including the Distinguished Scientist Award from the Society for a Science of Clinical Psychology, American Psychological Association, the Louis I. Dublin Award for Lifetime Achievement in the Field of Suicide as well as awards for Distinguished Research in Suicide (American Foundation of Suicide Prevention), Distinguished Contributions to the Practice of Psychology (American Association of Applied and Preventive Psychology), Distinguished Contributions for Clinical Activities (Association for the Advancement of Behavior Therapy), and Distinguished Scientific Contributions to Clinical Psychology (Society of Clinical Psychology, American Psychological Association). She is also the past-president of the Association for the Advancement of Behavior Therapy.

Dr. Linehan has studied Spiritual Direction at Shalem Institute of Spiritual Formation as well as Christian Contemplation under the personal guidance of Zen master and Benedictine monk Fr. Willigis Jaeger, O.S.B., Ko-un Roshi. She formally began Zen practice in 1986 as a student of Jaeger Roshi and in 2002 as a student of Zen master Pat Hawk Roshi. With Fr. Jaeger Roshi, she has translated aspects of both Zen and Contemplative practices into behaviorally specific instructions for mindfulness practice that can be taught to clients in psychotherapy.

Shari Manning, Ph.D., is President of the South Carolina Center for Dialectical Behavior Therapy, P.C., a comprehensive clinic that has offered standard outpatient and intensive DBT treatment for adults and adolescents. She is the President and CEO of Behavioral Tech, LLC and Behavioral Tech Research, Inc. Dr. Manning consults extensively to state mental health programs at all levels of client care, including forensic and criminal justice settings. Her research includes investigations of the efficacy of DBT with incarcerated women with borderline personality disorder (BPD) and with adult women with comorbid BPD and eating disorders. Dr. Manning has written several published chapters on DBT and its implementation.
